all Rules

- 1. TEAMS MUST PITCH TO OPPOSING TEAM.
- 2. PLAYERS ARE ABLE TO STEAL AFTER THE BALL CROSSES HOME PLATE. THERE IS ONLY 1 BASE ALLOWED AT A TIME. RUNNERS CANNOT ADVANCE ON AN OVERTHROW.
- 3. THE BATTER IS OUT ON THE THIRD STRIKE REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE BALL IS CAUGHT. THE BALL REMAINS LIVE.
- 4. AN INNING SHALL BE COMPLETE WHEN:
- A) THERE ARE 3 OUTS OR
- B) FIVE (5) RUNS.
- 5. THE NUMBER OF PLAYERS ON THE FIELD SHALL BE NINE (9).
- 6. NO AUTOMATIC OUTS IF LESS THEN NINE (9) PLAYERS.
- 7. NO SWITCHING OF PLAYERS FROM ONE TEAM TO ANOTHER.
- 8. COMPETENT UMPIRES ARE REQUIRED FOR THE SEASON AND 1 CARDED UMPIRE FOR THE YEAR END TOURNAMENT.
- 9. THE INNING IS COMPLETE ONCE FIVE(5) RUNS HAVE SCORED. <u>NO PLAYER</u> LEFT ON BASE SHALL RETURN TO THAT BASE NEXT INNING.
- 10. NO NEW INNING TO START AFTER ONE (1) HOUR UNLESS AGREED UPON BY BOTH COACHES.
- 11. ALL CATCHERS MUST WEAR AN APPROVED THROAT GUARD, MASK AND HELMET AS WELL AS A CHEST PROTECTOR JOCK/JILL AND SHIN PADS AS PER SOFTBALL CANADA RULES. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- 12. ALL BATTERS AND RUNNERS MUST WEAR HELMETS WITH FACE GUARD FASTENED SECURELY TO THE HEAD BY A STRAP FITTED UNDER THE CHIN AS PER SOFTBALL CANADA RULES. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- 13. MITES USE AN 11" BALL. THE PITCHING DISTANCE IS 30' AND THE BASE DISTANCE IS 45'.
- 14. RULES NOT COVERED SEE SOFTBALL CANADA.
